Dr. Ouki has about thirty years' experience of managing and executing gas and energy-related technoeconomic projects throughout the world. He led numerous commercial consulting projects commissioned by governments; national and international energy companies; financial institutions; and, multilateral development agencies. Dr. Ouki has overseen and carried out assignments for the development of local gas monetization projects and in support of LNG and cross-border gas pipeline projects. He also managed consulting assignments on the development of oil, gas and petrochemical infrastructure projects in key hydrocarbon producing countries in the Middle East North Africa region.

Dr. Ouki was a member of the senior team of advisers working with four West African governments on the development of the West African Gas Pipeline project. More recently he has been involved in the provision of advisory services to African government agencies in the planning and implementation of gas-to-power projects, as well as advising a Middle Eastern government in the proposed reform of the country's gas pricing framework.

Dr. Ouki started his career with the Gas Exports Directorate of Algeria's oil and gas company Sonatrach in Algiers and worked in Washington, D.C. on gas development projects for the World Bank. Prior to the formation of Nexant, he was with Bechtel's energy technology and consulting division and worked for the oil and gas engineering company Penspen in London.
